An Act to amend laws pertaining to the powers and operations of People's Militia

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanzania.

1. This Act may be cited as the People's Militia Laws (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act, 1989.

Short title

2. Section 2 of the Peoples Militia (Compensation for Death or Injuries) Act, 1973, is hereby amended by deleting the definition "Peoples Militia" and substituting for it the following:

Amendment of Act No. 27 of 1973

"Peoples Militia" means an organized group of the people of the United Republic, operating with the authority of and under the aegis of the Government and which is receiving any military training or participating in any military, quasi military or law enforcement exercise for the protection of the sovereignty of the United Republic or for the protection of the people or the property of the United Republic, by whatever name known, whether as *Wasalama*, *Sungusungu* or any other, but does not include the Police Force, any arm or branch of the Defence Forces, the Prisons Service, the National Service or the Immigration Services."

3. Section 2 of the Peoples Militia (Powers of Arrest) Act, 1975, is hereby amended by deleting the definition "Peoples Militia" and substituting for it the following:

Amendment of section 2 of Act No. 25 of 1975
